— AIR-COVERED YARN

The Air-jet Covered Yarn needs sizing for warp knitting and can be used for weft knitting directly. The production efficiency of Air-Covered Yarn is much higher than Conventional Covered Yarn (also known as SCY – Single Covered Yarn or DCY – Double Covered Yarn) and the price is also much lower, which would reduce much cost for downstream textile company.

The manufacturing of air-covered yarns is an efficient production process and our manufacturing partners strive to make it all the more cost-effective. In this process, the elastane component intermingles with a filament yarn using compressed air and it is wound straight onto the yarn spool.



Air-covered yarns with their powdery look and exceptional softness are best used for socks and seamless articles.

The most commonly used ACY is **elastane with Polyester, PBT and Nylon**. They are mainly used for **socks, denims and seamless articles**.
