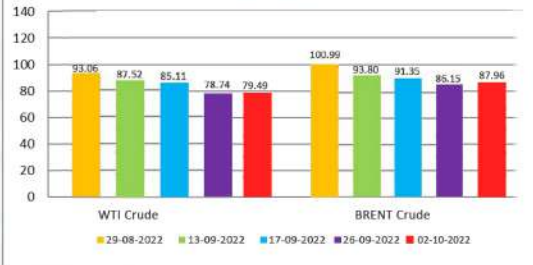

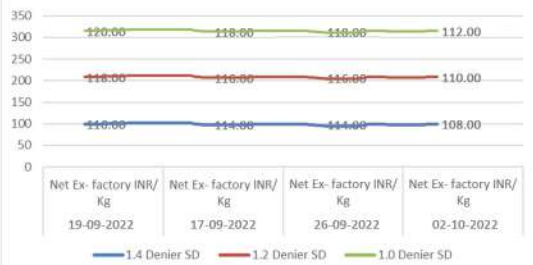

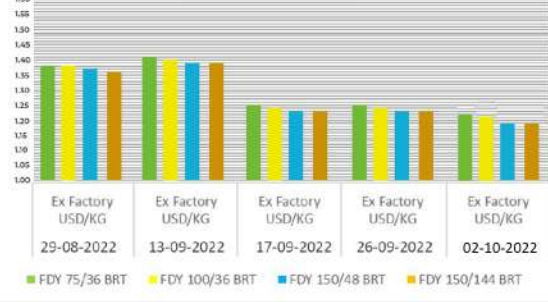

## — CUT RESISTANT FABRIC

Cut resistant fabrics are made with polymeric and non polymeric high performance fibres such as high tenacity polyester, nylon, lyotropic polymer fibres, gel spun fibres and thermotropic liquid crystal polymer fibres. New products are also made with core and wrapped yarns by suitable combination of specialty fibres and yarns in different fabric weaves. The level of cut resistance provided by the reinforcing yarns depends on the way in which they are



incorporated in the textile substrate. With regard to many different fabric manufacturing techniques available, a large number of alternatives for developing cut resistant textiles are feasible.
